C & C Training/Healthy Horse Tips



Above: Grasp the bottom of foot. Below: Lift toe.



Have problems picking up your horse's feet? Don't get in a tug of war with them. Instead, grasp the bottom of the hoof securely, wrapping your hand around the toe (top left photo). If your horse tries to take its foot away, simply lift the toe upward, flexing the pastern joint (bottom left photo). Release as soon as the horse relaxes the leg.

For a colicing horse, you can use the following holistic remedies to supplement regular veterinary care:

Aconitum for shock, Arsenicum for colic, and Arnica Montana for pain/swelling

You can find these at most health food stores and some chiropractors carry them.
